Volunteer Requirements:

We are an all-volunteer organization and there are many places for our families to share their time and talents – Game Day Coordinator, Concessions, Equipment Manager, Spirit Wear, Fundraising, Game Program just to name a few. To fully staff home games each family must

complete a minimum number of volunteer credits during the season (TBD based on game schedule and number of families participating). It is reasonable to expect at least 4 per family.

Fees

Varsity: \$450 per player which includes the following: Immediate Family Admission Pass to all Eagles home games, all necessary equipment (except shoes), and spirit wear pack that includes shorts, t-shirts, and hoodie. Also includes the end of the year banquet and awards.

Junior High: \$350 per player which includes the following: Immediate Family Admission Pass to all Eagles home games, all necessary equipment (except shoes), and spirit wear pack that includes shorts and t-shirts. Also includes the end of the year banquet and awards.

Family Multiplayer Discount: Oldest player pays full price fee. Each subsequent child receives a discount of \$100.

Late Fee: All fees are due on or before July 22nd. Families will be charged a \$50 fee for late payments.

- Remember that the football program is a learning experiences for players and that mistakes are sometimes made. Praise athletes in their attempt to improve themselves as.
- Learn the rules of the game, so that you may understand and appreciate why certain situations take place.
- A ticket is a privilege to observe the contest, not a license to verbally assault others and be generally obnoxious.
- Respect the integrity and judgment of game officials. Understand that they are doing their best to help promote the athlete, and admire the official's willingness to participate in full view of the public.

- Use of any controlled substances (alcohol, tobacco drugs, etc.) on or near the site of the event before, during, or after the game, practice or any Eagles Football sponsored event is prohibited.
