

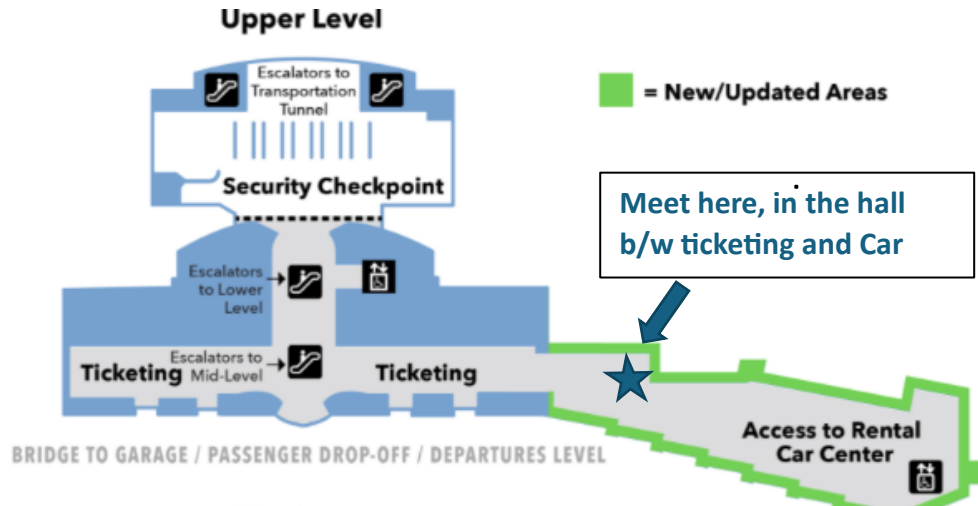
Homeschool Football Classic, Dallas 2024

Frontier Airlines

Wed. Aug. 21: 12:30pm, Flight 4772, CVG → ATL (arrival 2:04pm)

3:05pm, Flight 2495, ATL → DFW (arrival 4:32pm)

Sat. Aug. 24: 7:57pm, Flight 4280, DFW → CVG (arrival 11:25pm)



Arrive at Cincinnati International Airport at 9:30am on Wed., Aug. 21. Check in your athlete via the Frontier Airlines app – there is an additional fee to check in at the counter. You only need to go to the counter if you are checking baggage. Once you have addressed any carryon/checked baggage issues (if applicable), meet the rest of the team on the Upper Level (same level as ticketing/check-in) of the terminal, following signs toward Ground Transportation West (meet inside the terminal in that hallway). Once all are accounted for and everyone's e-ticket is in hand, we will then proceed to the security checkpoint together. Each chaperone will be assigned a group of 5 athletes that they will be responsible for during the trip from Cincinnati to Dallas. It is important that your athlete is attentive to the instructions of his/her chaperone throughout the trip, but especially on the travel days.

You will have time to purchase lunch at the airport before your flight. Restaurants include Chick-fil-a, Wendy's, Skyline, and sandwich restaurants. An empty water bottle that can be filled after clearing security and snacks for the trip are suggested. You will **not** have time to purchase food when we are connecting in Atlanta.

Note that Landmark purchased the most basic tickets. Included is ONE personal item, see below for description. If you wish to bring a larger carryon item, you can purchase that on your own from the Frontier Airlines app, or at the airport at the ticket counter. It is cheaper to purchase the carryon or bag check when you're checking in on the Frontier app -- it will cost more if you wait until you get to the airport. Coach Hatfield has graciously volunteered to drive to Dallas, pulling a trailer with football and cheer gear, equipment, and any luggage that the athletes will need in Dallas. The trailer will be loaded Tuesday evening at practice, and is scheduled to arrive in Dallas on Wednesday evening. Therefore, you should only

need to have in your personal item (at the airport) your essentials (ID, money, phone charger, snacks, toothbrush, toothpaste, necessary medications, spare t-shirt, shorts, and underwear just in case of an unexpected flight delay).

Meals

- The Eagle News recently had great information about the meal plans for the trip. I refer you to that for full details. To keep things simple and ensure every athlete is eating while in Dallas, we will be hosting 5 meals at the Riley Center. For athletes, Landmark is covering most of the cost of those meals – each athlete is required to purchase a \$26 meal pass to help offset the remainder of the cost. Coaches, chaperones, and any family that is in Dallas that wants to join us for the meals can purchase a Family Meal Pass for \$57 per person (includes all 5 of the meals).
- *If you have a food allergy, please email landmarkeaglesfootball@gmail.com with specific allergy information to see if we can accommodate those needs. If not, we will ensure the athlete will be able to go to the grocery store for meal items.*

6:30pm: Team Spaghetti Dinner, w/ worship/devotion following

10:00pm: Lights out

Fri.: 8:30am: Cheer leaves to AT&T (will be cheering at all 4 games)

1:30pm: Football leaves to AT&T

4:30pm: GAMETIME! (vs. Christ Prep, from Kansas City, MO)

Sat.: 11:00am: Serve Day with Joni and Friends, at Cowboys training facility

5:00pm: Arrive at the airport by this time, to prepare for the flight home

When picking up your athlete at the airport on Saturday evening (expected to arrive 11:25pm EASTERN time), please use the lower-level baggage claim pick up area. Check the status of Frontier Flight 4280 after 9pm on Saturday, August 24, to verify what time you need to arrive to the airport. Lengthy delays or early arrivals will be communicated via TeamSnap as well
